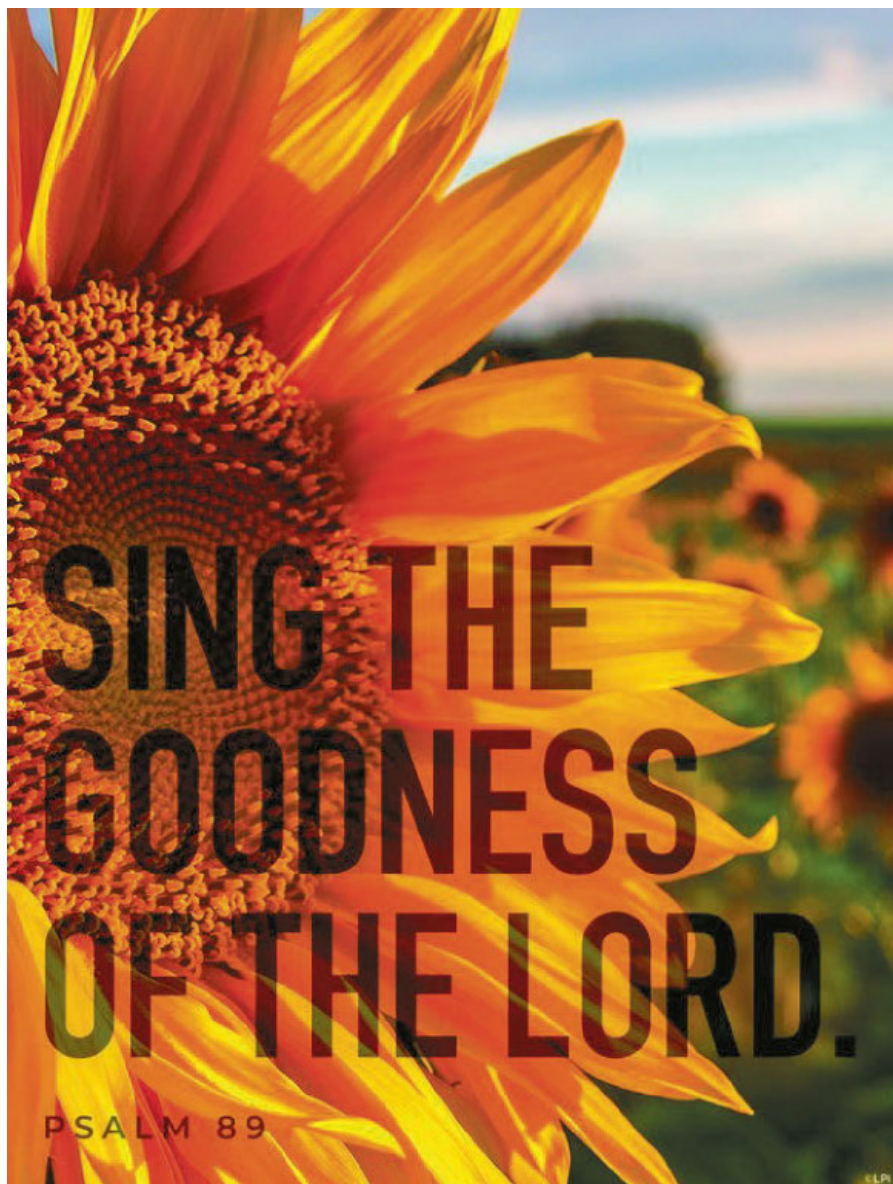

Dear Friends,

I'm writing today to share the results of parish-wide discussions held recently about the condition and usage of Saints JFX's two campuses. Just like any family homeowner, Saints JFX must maintain our beautiful churches and buildings and make important decisions about where to focus resources.

To ensure that we are supporting our campuses in ways that best serve all our needs, we engaged the Lakota Group, a consulting firm that specializes in urban design, planning, landscape architecture, and historic preservation. The Lakota Group is leading a team that will create a comprehensive master plan, the Saints JFX One Plan, to guide us in investing in the right balance of academic, religious, recreational, athletic, and social spaces for the parish.

Step one of this process involved listening to the opinions and needs of the people who use our campuses along with our neighbors. Specifically, Lakota's planning team, in collaboration with Saints JFX staff, held listening sessions on April 27th and 28th. Over the course of 12 hour-long sessions, the team spoke with 90+ individuals encompassing perspectives of parishioners at large, students, faculty and staff, teachers, parents, committee members, and the larger Wilmette community.

Summarized below are the key themes that emerged from these enlightening discussions:

Embrace Our Spiritual Second Home. Saints JFX bestows a warm, welcoming, and dynamic community with strong leadership and schools. Many parishioners expressed their pride and love for the Saints JFX Parish and community while also voicing their desire for spaces where the entire parish can come together. They felt the One Plan should ensure there is space for worship, gathering, serving the larger community, education, learning, and recreation.

Build Community Through Gathering Spaces. One particularly strong theme emerged – the need to develop a variety of community gathering spaces. Those interviewed envisioned a variety of types of new community gathering spaces, including indoor areas connected to the existing churches for year-round use, outdoor spaces that provide green options for recreation and seasonal events, as well as academic spaces for reading, meetings, and play. These gathering spaces should be versatile, adaptable, and multi-purpose, serving multiple functions, supporting parish and academic programming, and benefiting both campuses.


Support Existing Programming and Uses. Interviewees expressed a desire to ensure that our campuses offer enhanced spaces for all current uses. These include more space for one-on-one meetings for teachers, staff, and students, outdoor learning spaces, more or improved recreation space for kids of all ages, private space for faculty, meditation and quiet space, indoor activity spaces, and storage space for programming.

Embrace Connectivity, Accessibility, and a Cohesive Identity. Parishioners wish to see more unity between the Saint Joseph and Saint Francis Xavier campuses, while enhancing the visual appearance along Lake Avenue. The One Plan should use signage, color, and other design elements to further connect the two campuses and provide a more cohesive environment. It will be important to maintain the character of the historic buildings across both campuses, while improving safety and accessibility.

For next steps, Lakota's planning team will incorporate these key themes into initial concept studies to illustrate the exciting opportunities and enhancements for our parish. Please stay tuned for upcoming details about a parish workshop, where you will have the opportunity to delve into these concepts, share your thoughts and ideas, and actively contribute to shaping the future of Saints JFX. My thanks to all who have participated in the listening sessions and provided input. Great things are happening at Saints JFX with the help of our many parishioners who share their time and talents. And speaking of thanks, I hope you have received my invitation to our *Saints JFX Volunteer Thank You Get Together* on July 19 from 5 to 8 pm! You can see the invitation in this bulletin.

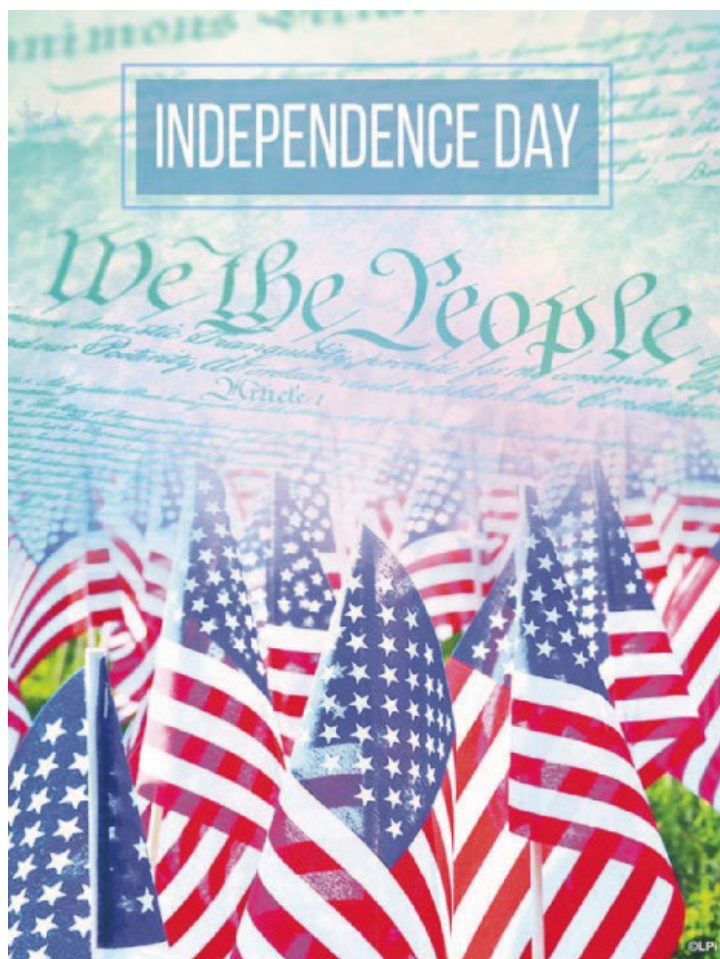

As we've previously announced, this upcoming school year Saints JFX will be moving away from the traditional "Sunday YFF/RE/PREP classes" to a new program called Family of Faith. There have been questions about Family of Faith as we've introduced the program; over the next several weeks we'll be presenting frequently asked questions and answers to share information. Q. Why is the parish changing from the traditional classroom Religious Education to the Family of Faith program?

A. We want to introduce your children to a real, personal relationship with Christ, and strengthen and guide them throughout their lives in the most effective way possible. THE most powerful teacher for children on their path of life is their own parents!

Studies have shown that when both parents actively practice the faith, the majority of their children will too – that is still true even today. When one or both parents do not practice, most likely their children will not practice the faith as adults. Our Family of Faith program is designed to fortify both the faith and the family. We want to give your families the strength, joy, and warmth that only God can give!

Q. What is "Family of Faith"? How much time does it take to complete this new program?

A. The Family of Faith Program is a new religious education initiative. It concentrates on supporting and strengthening families in both faith and their family unity. The program results in strengthening both the family and parish life as a great "Family of Faith." It builds upon the most powerful element of effective faith transmission, the family.

This program has a cycle of four years. The complete course is an introduction to all aspects of Catholic faith, life and morals. Through it, the students and their parents will grow together in their spiritual journey, through attendance at Mass, regular family activities, prayer, and participation in parish life. Instead of being something external, isolated, or merely obligatory at times for various reasons, students will come to understand and value their religion as a way of life—for all their lives!

Q. What materials do we get/need?

A. You will receive one parent book with information you need to teach your children the faith. This is included with your registration fee. Each child will receive an activity book with resources and activities to learn each theme for the year. These are included with your registration fee. You will also need to have basic art and school supplies for the activities. Each family will need a Bible (New American Bible) and a Catechism of the Catholic Church. These can be purchased from Amazon or from any Catholic book store.

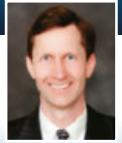
