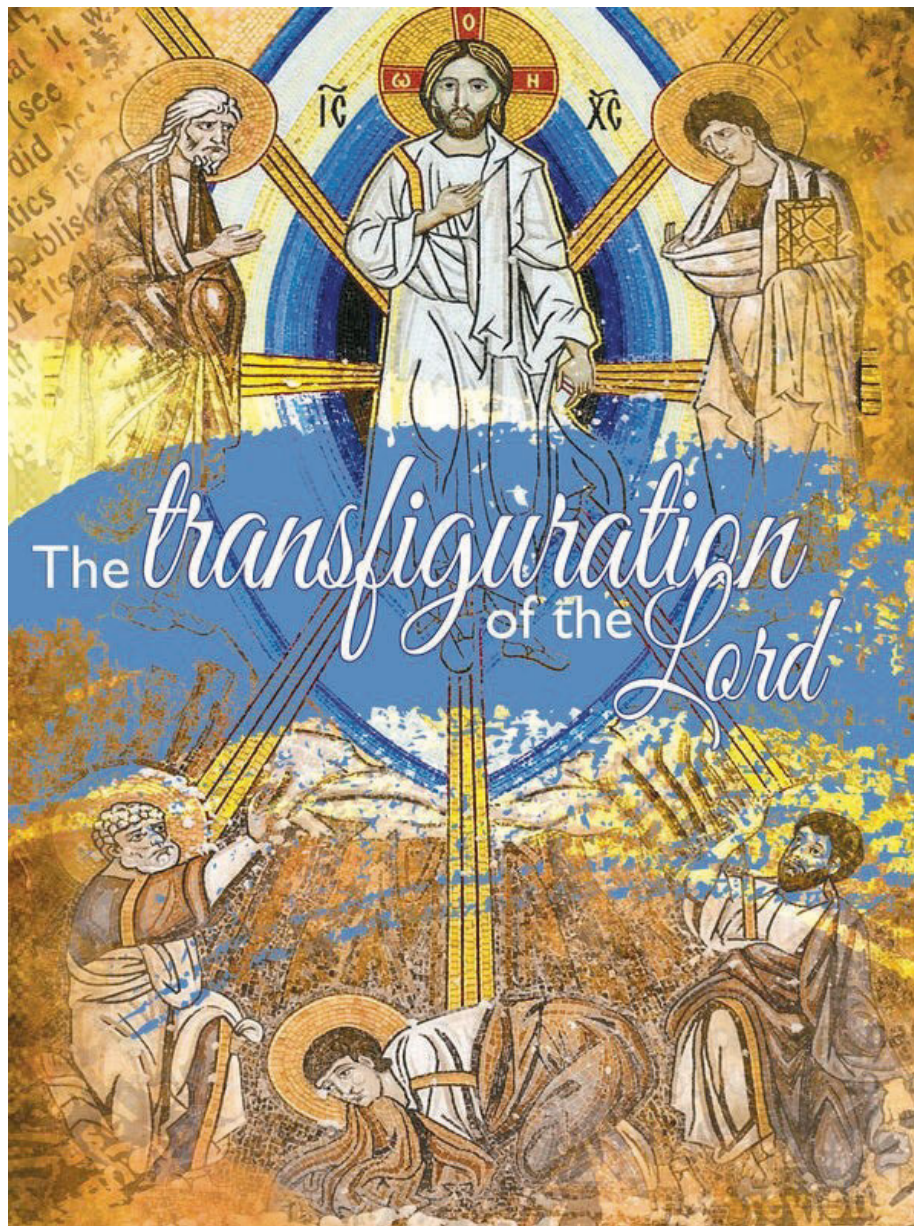

Dear Friends,

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord. Jesus takes Peter, James, and John up on a high mountain to pray, to encounter the Lord, to see God's glory, and then to return to the important mission of evangelization, bringing God's love to the troubled world in which they lived. These mountaintop experiences help, but if we keep our eyes open, even in our day-to-day world, we can encounter the Lord and will see God's glory so that we, too, can participate in the mission of evangelization, and bring God's love into our own troubled world.

As I read the lines of today's Gospel, two commands stand out, one from God the Father and one from God the Son. If we allow these lines to pierce our hearts, fill our minds and direct our actions, we will accomplish great things.

On the Mountain of the Transfiguration, the voice that comes from cloud both exclaims and commands. The voice describes Jesus as the beloved Son with whom God is well pleased. Then, the voice tells Peter, James, and John (and us, presumably) to listen to Jesus. It sounds so simple, recognizing the Son of God and listening to him. Sadly, though, our eyes can be blinded and prevented from recognizing Jesus in our midst and hearing his voice. Too many distractions and false gods tempt us to strive for their acquisition and attention. The noise that surrounds us can prevent us from hearing Jesus, let alone actually listening to him.

We can see him, recognize him, and listen to him in the celebration of the Mass. We hear his voice in Sacred Scriptures and see his glory in his real presence in the Eucharistic Host. I write this missive as I wrap up my annual pilgrimage to Lourdes. I write from Barcelona. Throughout the pilgrimage, we have celebrated daily Mass. As we celebrated the Mass in different churches and chapels across France and Spain, I couldn't help but feel so grateful for the Eucharist, the universality of the Church, and the closeness of God in the Mass. I thought of the over 100 people who attend daily Mass in our two beautiful churches in Wilmette and my connection to them, even though I am thousands of miles away.

We can recognize Jesus and listen to him as his voice strikes our hearts and we see him in the eyes of the poor, the forgotten and the broken. On Tuesday evening we celebrated Mass in an old historic church near our hotel. I just wandered in on Tuesday morning. When I entered the sanctuary, half of it was occupied by volunteers sitting at tables welcoming and assisting those in need. I asked one of the social service workers, if it were possible to celebrate Mass. She directed me outside to the people who are welcoming the homeless and the hungry. I asked them

about celebrating Mass. They called the priest, and he said that we were more than welcome. He also said that at the same time we would be celebrating Mass, volunteers would be serving dinner to the homeless and hungry below the church.



What a beautiful image! Jesus feeds young pilgrims in the Eucharist while dedicated volunteers encounter Jesus in the eyes of the poor and feed them themselves. Recognize Jesus and listen to Jesus. Simple.

Jesus' line in the Gospel, "Rise and do not be afraid," reminds us that when we recognize him, listen to him, and allow ourselves to be strengthened by him, we have nothing to fear. Jesus always gives us what we need and prepares us, as he did his imperfect disciples, to be witness of his love and bringers of his peace. Fear gets in the way of doing his will.

Rise. He tells them, and us, to get up, to act. Christian discipleship cannot be a passive life. Discipleship requires us to rise, to not be afraid, to act and to make a difference in the world. My young pilgrims have committed to fearlessly acting, to bring God's love into the world. My guess is that the million or so young people in Lisbon today are being invited to do the same. Let's join them. Recognize the Son. Listen to him. Rise and do not be afraid.

### Secretary Alexi Giannoulias Announces *Skip-the-Line* Program at High-Volume DMVs

Appointments and new extended hours are part of the new initiative to save customers' time.

In an effort to improve customer service and eliminate the unpredictability of wait times at Illinois DMVs, Secretary of State Alexi Giannoulias will implement the *Skip-the-Line* program on **September 1**.

- Required appointments will reduce wait times.
- Extended hours offer more availability.
- ILSOS.gov offers a variety of services that do not require an in-person visit to a facility or office.

#### The Skip-the-Line Program includes:

**Appointment scheduling** – Customers will be required to make appointments for in-person visits at 44 of the busiest DMVs. All Chicago and suburban locations and select central and downstate DMVs will require an appointment for REAL IDs, driver's licenses and ID card services, and in-car driving tests.

Vehicle-related services – such as titles, registrations or license plate renewals – do not require an appointment. Please visit [ilsos.gov](http://ilsos.gov) or call (844) 817-4649 to schedule an appointment.

**New extended hours of operation** – Every DMV will extend hours of operation beginning September 1. Select facilities will be open six days a week – Monday through Saturday.

All DMVs will have hours of operation from Mon-Fri, 8 a.m.-5:30 p.m.

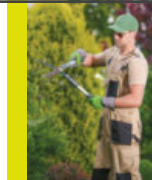
