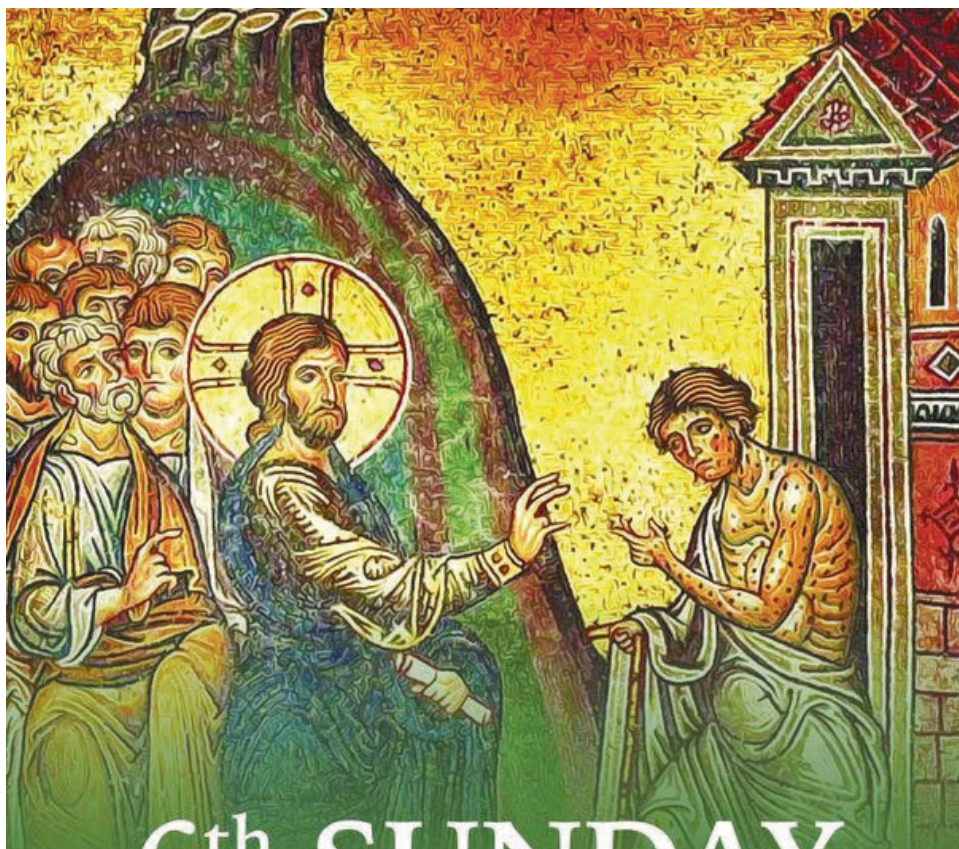

Dear Friends,

The leper broke the rules. Jesus did too. We can learn from both of them.

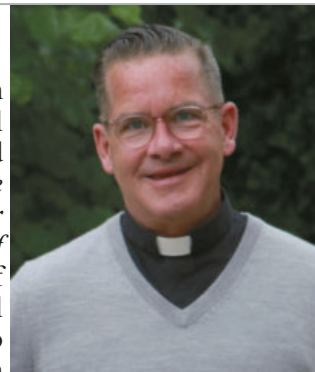
As we listen to the first reading from the book of Leviticus, we hear strong, harsh guidance given to those who suffer from leprosy. They were reminded to stay far from society, and to declare themselves unclean, whenever a "clean" person approaches them. Simply because of their ailment, they were ostracized from society. I imagine that the life of a leper was one of the loneliness and dejection. Ignored, avoided, judged, and alone, they lived on the peripheries of society.

Jesus shows us the way in this weekend's Gospel. Both the leper, and our Lord, break the rules. The leper was commanded from the time of Leviticus to stay away. The leper should have shouted, "unclean, unclean." Instead, the leper approached Jesus, came close to him, and broke the Levitical law. He must have seen something in Jesus that told him to disregard policy and approach the one who had power to heal him. Something drew him to Jesus. This is a great example to all of us to approach the Lord with whatever is hurting us, ailing us, or making us feel alone and rejected. No matter what that is, we are invited to bring it to the Lord. The season of lent is a great time to do that.

The leper's confidence strikes me. Not only did he boldly break societies rules, but he also professed his faith in the power of Jesus, saying, "If you will it, you can make me clean." After years of rejection, he mustered the courage to approach and ask. It begs some questions for each of us, "What do I need from the Lord today? Do I believe that he can do it? Do I have the courage, humility, and faith to approach and ask?"

The response of Jesus to the leper in today's gospel gives reason to trust, to hope, and to approach the Lord. Mark tells us that Jesus responded immediately to the request of the leper and did something that probably no one had ever done to him. After the leper professed his faith, and made his request to the Lord, Jesus, moved with pity, reached out his hand, and touched the leper. He *touch*ed him! He risked contracting the disease himself. He broke all the rules of society and followed his Father's law of love. Then he said, "I do will it. Be made clean." Just reading that verse gives me confidence to approach Jesus with my own brokenness and seek his mercy and his love.

Many of you were present when former parishioner and school alumna, Meg Kissinger, returned to speak about her book, *While You Were Out, A Family Memoir of Mental Illness in an Era of Silence*, and raise awareness of people struggling with mental illness – and the need to welcome them and walk with them. She recently wrote an essay about the experience, published in America Magazine. So many live today on society's peripheries. So many experience being ignored, dejected, avoided and judged. Pope Francis reminds us that the Church must be a field hospital in our world, bringing the salve of the mercy of God to those who are on the periphery, to those the world shuns. Perhaps, as we begin our journey of lent on Wednesday, we can commit to keeping our eyes open with keen awareness of the needs of those who are often ignored. Let's look for them and bring God's love and mercy to them in the best way that we can.

PS This weekend, we hear from the Cardinal, requesting our participation in the Annual Catholic Appeal. I hope for great participation from Saints JFX. Consider what you pledged and gave last year, please, and try to give a little more. That's what I'm going to do.

I consider this appeal as important as my Sunday contributions. I mentioned last weekend that I divide my stewardship dollars. 30% goes to Saints JFX, 30% to the ACA and 30% to Catholic Charities. The remaining dollars go to other great causes. My participation in the ACA allows me to support our local community, the Church of Chicago, and the universal Church. When we meet our goal of about \$165,000, the rest comes to us as a rebate. We use the rebate money to complete capital projects that we otherwise couldn't.

### Inspiring Pastoral Outreach

Join the AWC for one of three Zoom discussions on pastoral approaches to persons in unchangeable positions that put them in conflict with the teachings of the Catholic Church (for example, Catholics who are divorced and re-married without an annulment, who identify as LGBTQIA+, are in inter-religious marriages, whose marriages were not blessed by the Church, etc.).

Our goal is to hear the voices of 200 or more women. Discussion will address the following:

- Do the Church's current practices towards persons in these situations attract people to or drive them away from the Catholic Church?
- What are some pastoral approaches that you have seen, or would like to see, toward persons who are in these situations? In what ways could we encourage them and help them feel comfortable coming to church?
- Do you or do people you know feel injured or harbor resentment when exceptions are made for people in these situations?

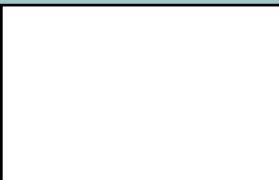
