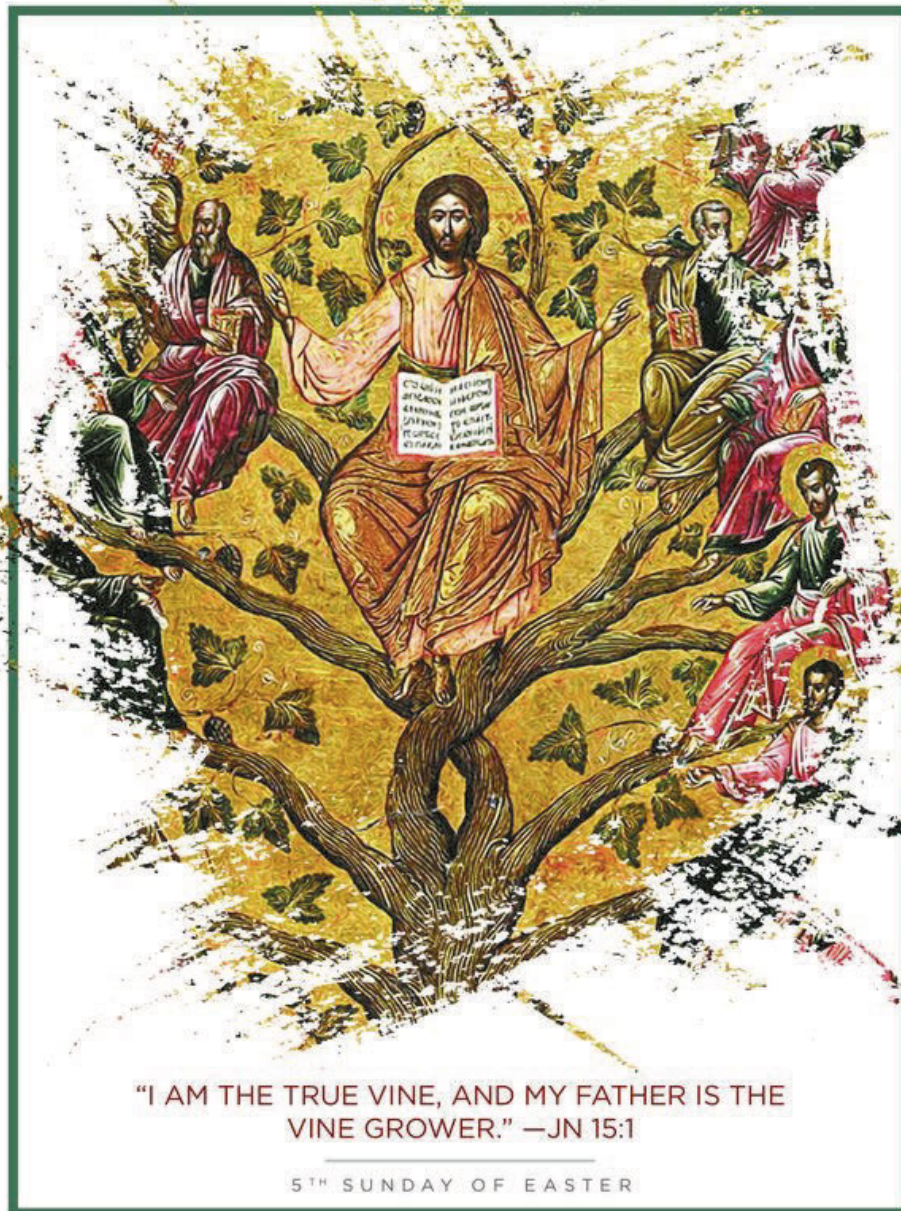

Dear Friends,

*Jesus said to his disciples: "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower. Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing.*

Last month, I had the great blessing of visiting Napa Valley for the wedding of one of our parishioners. Besides witnessing the beauty of the couple exchanging their vows, a true image of God's love for us, in the presence of two amazing families and a beautiful group of loyal friends, I had the privilege of visiting the vineyard of the family of a friend of mine. Rows and rows of vines filled the Saint Helena hillside. From the road, the individual vines blended and looked like streams of green against the dark soil. A closer look showed a woody strong "vine" and tiny fragile branches. Jesus knew what he was talking about. He is the strong vine, and we are the tiny, fragile branches.

We met the vine grower at the vineyard, a man very proud of the vine, the branches, and the fruit. I thought of how God must be so pleased with his creation, the beauty of nature, and the goodness, the real goodness of humanity. I felt called that day, in a special way, to stay connected, in my own weakness, to the sturdy vine, and to do my best to produce good fruit.

Jesus promises that if we remain connected to the vine, that if we remain in him, we will produce much fruit. At Saints JFX, we experience that. We strive as a people to stay always connected to the life-giving source that is Christ. We answer the invitation to remain connected, and we believe in the promise that if we do, we will bear much fruit. Just think of all that has been accomplished here.

No one can take credit because Jesus, the source of all life, makes the fruit come. We have seen the fruit. We have seen increased attendance at Mass, and a greater involvement of families and individuals in the work of this great place. And we have spread the love of God to the margins of society, welcoming the refugee and feeding the hungry. Just this week, some

senior citizens of this great parish made a commitment to making 100 bag lunches for the clients of Catholic Charities every Tuesday, and the Men's Club is organizing regular visits to support and help serve downtown at Catholic Charities' Tuesday Night Supper feeding the hungry and the homeless. We do all this good, or, better said, **Jesus** does this good through us, because we stay connected to the vine. We're bearing fruit.



During the Easter Season, we continue to read the Acts of the Apostles and hear about the works of the Early Church. The ideal Christian community, as described in Acts, a community closely connected with the ministry of Jesus, and one that experienced his teaching, passion, death, and resurrection, lived peacefully. It walked in the fear of the Lord. It received the consolation of the Holy Spirit. Because of all that, the Church was being built. Is our Church at peace? Do we walk in the fear of the Lord? Do we readily receive the consolation and guidance of the Holy Spirit? When we as a local Church, and as a universal one, can say "yes" to those questions we will continue to experience growth in numbers and in the fruits of our work.

What can we do? I advise taking the words of the Letter of Saint John to heart. He says, "Children, let us love not in word or speech, but in deed and truth." I think of expressions like, "Practice what you preach," or "Walk the talk." As Catholics in an increasingly irreligious world, we must be models of good behavior and joyful spirit. Let's not just talk about loving our neighbor, but let's really love our neighbor. Love in deed - indeed.

**Parish Pastoral Council (PPC)** is the main consultative body of the parish and exercises shared responsibility for the Pastoral life of the parish with the Pastor. This includes defining parish goals, setting broad strategies for implementing those goals, and evaluating the parish's success in carrying out the Church's mission.

The council represents a cross section of the parish. Meetings are held on the 3rd Monday of the month, September - June. In addition to monthly meetings, members are asked to serve on sub-committees such as Stewardship, Hospitality, and Youth Faith Formation. This past year, one of our key accomplishments was the completion of a parish-wide survey.

**Finance Council** assists the Pastor in discharging his responsibilities in the administration, management, and stewardship of the financial affairs of the parish. The Finance Council works with the Pastor and the Director of Operations in preparing and approving the annual budget, overseeing and approving major capital expenditures, and producing and communicating the Annual Report of the Parish Finances to Parishioners. Furthermore, the Council is charged with reviewing the operating results and providing important guidance in the financial management of the parish.

Meetings are held on the 4th Monday of the month, September – June. In addition to the monthly meeting, council volunteers are asked to work on sub-committees to actively work on Parish finance projects. Terms are 3 years and the preferred number of volunteers for the Finance Council is between 9 and 12.

The council is open to all parishioners and strives to have a mix of professional backgrounds including, but not limited to, finance, accounting, legal, marketing, consulting, and fundraising from both parish and school individuals across a range of age groups.
