Dear Friends,

Happy Mother's Day! Happy Ascension Day, too! Only occasionally do these days coincide in the United States Church. It's appropriate, though, that they do today. When we celebrate motherhood, we also honor their response to God's call, to their vocation in life. On the day of the Ascension, Jesus told his disciples to go and make disciples. He commanded them to teach those that they baptize in the ways of the faith. He promised that if they stay close to him and keep his commands, they would be able to do great things in his name. Mothers do just that.

I met with our eighth graders this week and asked them why they thought we should honor mothers. I asked them to tell me what they thought mothers' most important jobs entailed. The wisdom of the soon-to-be graduates might make you smile, or chuckle - or go home and redefine the role of mother. According to these fourteen year olds, mothers:

- Do and teach what is right even when it is hard.
- Make sure we are well taken care of.
- Love their children unconditionally.
- Are always supportive.
- Are patient and forgiving.
- Raise us to be who we are.
- Work hard to provide for our family.
- Take us to sports and cheer us on.
- Love us even when we don't show our love to them.
- Take care of their children no matter what they are going through.

My mother was a teacher, and taught me many lessons, as mothers do, in the eighteen years we had together. So I share with you some life lessons, some famous quotes of Dorothy Mary Watts.

**"There but for the Grace of God go I."** Telling her children not to be judgmental, and to appreciate what they have.

**"Don't let your eyes be bigger than your stomach."** Demanding that we not waste that which we have been given.

**"Don't be so uncharitable!"** A reminder to us of the importance of kindness in word and in deed.

**"It's a Corporal Work of Mercy."** Urging us to visit the sick, to bury the dead, to feed the hungry... to be generous with our lives.

**"There are no pockets in shrouds."** Gently letting us know that money isn't everything, and that we should share what we have.

**"Offer it up."** Highlighting the importance of sacrifice in our daily lives.

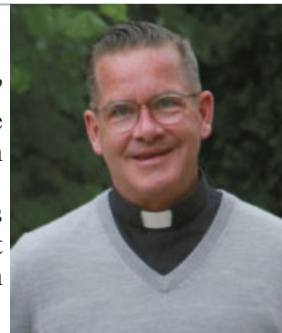
**"Singing is praying twice"**

Encouraging us to love life and express that love in song and prayer.

**"God provides."** Reminding us not to worry too much but to rather put our trust in God's providential care.

**"As long as you are living under our roof..."** Letting us know that the rules of the house (starting with the rule that everyone goes to church every Sunday) must be followed by all who live there.

**"God is good!"** Promoting a deep faith and love for the God who is always with us, and a spirit of gratitude to the One who gives us all that we have.



God *is* good. And in His goodness, He gave us our mothers. I am sure you carry lessons learned from your mothers. I thank God for my mother and the message of faith and love she shared with my brothers and sisters and me. So, as we celebrate mothers, let us remember God's Mother, and the example she gave us, especially in her YES to the will of God. As we enjoy the beautiful colors and warmer temperatures of spring, and continue the celebration of the Easter Season, stop for a moment to remember and to honor our mothers, and those who have been mother figures to us throughout our life.

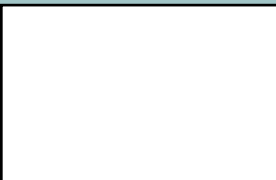
