
Our Mission:

I was asked to share a few thoughts for this Sunday's bulletin, and of course, the message is about music. I remember as a child (attending St. Francis school, by the way), our family always sang in the car. No matter if a short trip to the store or a long adventure to northern Wisconsin, the ride was always filled with music and singing. Memories of summer camp included songs by the campfire. One of my first jobs during and out of college was at a sing-along establishment next to the Loyola University downtown campus, where the patrons passed the night singing old-time favorites accompanied by banjo and piano.

In the early 70's, I developed a love for a different type of music, while subbing at Faith Hope church, OLPH, and finally for Walt Horn at St. Joseph. The sacred side of music was both prayerful and inspiring, and discovered many "doors": chant. Ι traditional, contemporary, and gospel. I began to really understand the phrase, "singing is like praying twice." Now, as music director at our St. Joseph campus, I often play very quietly so that I can hear the beautiful and soft singing by the congregation, still a bit shy, but definitely on key.

Over the past 10 years, we as a congregation have learned eight different Mass settings and have a repertoire of over 100 well-known hymns, both traditional and contemporary. I am proud that we are one of the most "musical" parishes in the area! And although singing still seems awkward for some of the folks in church, over time, we

all have become more comfortable and more engaged. A Sunday wouldn't pass without one or two members stopping by to tell me how they enjoyed the music, especially when the choir has performed one of their w o n d e r f u l a n d complex anthems.



In today's world full of stress and confusion, the power of music is even more healing. That's why our streamed Masses always include opening and closing songs, as well as sung Mass parts. I look forward to the day when we can all be together again, sharing the Mass and especially the music of the Mass. "Sing to the Lord a new song, for He has done marvelous deeds."
